



Black Hawk Folk Festival July 11, 2026 Artisan Registration Form

Black Hawk Folk Society invites artisans to become a part of our annual folk festival by displaying and selling their art in the Mt. Morris Town Park. Demonstration of the creation of your items is encouraged, but not required.

All products to be displayed or sold must be handmade by the artisan. We ask that new vendors who have not exhibited at previous festivals submit at least two clear photos of their work for our review. **Resale or flea-market-type items may not be displayed or sold; displays promoting political or religious causes are also not allowed.** Vendors who do not meet these conditions will be required to close their booth without a refund, but are welcome to stay and enjoy the festival.

The booth fee includes two adult-admission festival tickets, which will be printed by the June concert date. If attending the June concert, you may pick up your tickets at that time. To receive acknowledgment of your registration, you **MUST** supply a **stamped, self-addressed envelope or provide a clearly printed e-mail address.** If you do not send an SASE, your tickets will be held at the gate.

The gate will be open at 9 a.m. on Saturday, July 11, for setup. Please check in at the gate before you set up so we can direct you to your location. No vehicle parking is allowed inside the fenced park area; artisans will be allowed to drive into the fenced area to unload heavy and bulky items, and then can park their vehicles outside the fence along County G and access the park through the walk-in gate. Open mic begins at 10:30 AM; please allow time for setup. Booth spaces are flexible in size, approximately 15' x 15'.

Voluntary donations of items for our fund-raising raffle are appreciated. Your name will be included with each raffle item and will be announced throughout the day as we promote the raffle.
